Alex Schadenburg, executive director of the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition, and Chair of the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition International, will introduce and present the 80 minutes documentary, Fatal Flaws produced by EPC.

*"A thought-provoking journey through Europe and North America to ask one of the most fundamental philosophical questions of our time: should we be giving doctors the right in law to end the life of others by euthanasia or assisted suicide? Filmmaker Kevin Dunn uses powerful testimonies and expert opinion from both sides of the issue to uncover how these highly disputed laws affect society over time."*

Following the film Alex will be joined by Fr. C. Ryan McCarthy - Pastor of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary Catholic Church and the Archdiocese Moral Theologian, Glenn Tebb - Executive Dir. of the Indiana Catholic Conference, and (a medical professional).
